

SPECIFIC DRESS GUIDELINES

1. All clothing must be size appropriate. No exposed undergarments. No sagging pants. Oversized shirts used to conceal exposed undergarments are not acceptable. All jeans and pants must be worn at the hip line, regardless of the shirt length. All belts, fasteners, snaps, straps, etc. must be properly fastened and worn as intended. Belts should be clearly visible with no excessive length.
2. Headgear is not allowed on school campus or school buses. This includes hats, caps, sunglasses, bandanas, scarves, towels, wraps, stocking caps, hoods, large headbands, headphones, earbuds, or other forms of headgear.
3. Unnatural hair colors (purple, pink, green, blue, fluorescent, etc.), visible body piercing (with the exception of earrings), and/or facial ornaments are not permitted. Any body piercing jewelry or marking must be worn underneath outer clothing.
4. Trench coats, slickers, chains, or gang-related clothing or paraphernalia will not be permitted.
5. No clothing, jewelry, tattoos, body markings, and/or personal items with obscene or controversial wording or pictures will be allowed. This includes items or clothing depicting alcohol, drugs, bars and lounges, tobacco, sexually suggestive and/or offensive remarks. Items and clothing with pictures of blood, skulls, violence, death, and weapons are not permitted.
6. No see-through tops, bottoms, sports bras, halter tops, off the shoulder tops or tie-up blouses are permitted. Students must be fully clothed at all times. Bare midriffs, bare shoulders, bare sides and/or extremely tight clothing are not allowed.
7. Blouses and dresses with straps less than the width of a driver license or approximately 2 inches are not acceptable without a shirt underneath. A camisole or tank top is not considered a shirt.
8. Backless or deep-cut dresses and shirts are not acceptable. Any tops or dresses that are too revealing in the front or back will not be allowed.
9. The display of cleavage is unacceptable. Low cut blouses, tops, sweaters, etc. with plunging necklines are not acceptable.
10. Young men are strongly encouraged to wear shirttails tucked inside pants.
11. Jeans must be neat and clean. **They must be in good condition and have no holes or rips.** Decorative patches or other items must not be obscene or offensive in any manner. Cut-offs, etc. and/or ragged hems are unacceptable.
12. No underwear clothing should be worn as outerwear or exposed from underneath dresses, pants, shorts, or tops.
13. All shorts, dresses and skirts shall not be shorter than the bottom of the middle finger when the student is standing normally with both arms extended along side of the body or not shorter than approximately 4 inches above the top of the knee, whichever is longer.
14. **Swimsuits, gym shorts, tights, spandex shorts, yoga pants, biker pants, cotton sweat pants, see-through wind pants, nylon sports shorts and pants and physical education uniforms are not appropriate. Athletic warm-ups can only be worn with prior approval of the administration.**
15. Footwear shall be worn at all times. Beach shoes, house shoes, and slippers are not acceptable for school wear.
16. **Leggings and tights** may be worn with a skirt or dress that is the appropriate length described in Rule #13. If a student wears leggings, jeggings or tights, (for clarification, the difference between these items and pants is that pants contain a zipper and pockets) the top/skirt/dress shall not be shorter than approximately 4 inches above the top of the knee. The top/skirt/dress must make a complete circle around the individual and meet the length requirement.
17. With the approval of the Principal, the extra-curricular activity sponsor may establish additional rules for grooming and dress as a prerequisite for membership. (i.e. warm-up pants, sweats on game day only)

The school administration shall have the right to consider any current fashion to determine its acceptability for school wear.
